<b>Where does Funding from Title 1 come from?</b>	<p>“Title I-A: Improving Basic Programs is a federal program that helps students who are most at risk meet state academic standards and be proficient on state assessments. This program provides funding to districts and schools that can be used for professional development, extended-time programs, and other strategies to help raise achievement levels.”</p>
<b>What assessments are done for eligibility?</b>	<p><b>K-2</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• iStation every month in classroom (for all students as part of progress monitoring)</li> <li>• EasyCBM is once a month as part of Title program</li> <li>• Classroom benchmark assessments that happen three times a year (Skills Block benchmark assessment)</li> </ul> <p><b>3rd grade:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• iStation every month in classroom (for all students as part of progress monitoring)</li> <li>• EasyCBM is once a month as part of Title program</li> <li>• Classroom benchmark assessments that happen three times a year</li> </ul> <p><b>4th-8th grade:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• EasyCBM is once a month as part of Title program</li> <li>• NWEA benchmark assessment</li> <li>• Classroom benchmark assessments that happen three times a year</li> </ul>
<b>How do students graduate out of Title 1 services?</b>	<p>Students are assessed based on their ability level not at their grade level for progress monitoring. Students will graduate out once they reach or exceed grade level expectations.</p>
<b>What will my student be learning during the Title 1 program?</b>	<p><b>K-2</b> is mostly phonics instructions  <b>3-5</b> fluency, comprehension, vocabulary, some extra phonics when needed  <b>6-8</b> fluency, comprehension, vocabulary</p>
<b>If my student has an IEP, are they still eligible to receive Title 1 services?</b>	<p>A student with an IEP is eligible for the Title 1 program if they meet the criteria. The Title 1 program will serve as additional support to what they are receiving on their IEP.</p>
<b>Where will my student receive Title 1 services?</b>	<p>Title 1 students will be pulled out of the classroom and receive a separate curriculum provided by the Title 1 teacher.</p> <p>Students will be pulled out for no longer than 30 minutes at a time. This will not happen during direct instruction in the classroom.</p>
